3 The Stated Clerk presented information on communications received. Information on
4 authoritative interpretations from the Office of the General Assembly was shared. A
5 letter from Bruce Reyes-Chow, Linda Valentine, and Gradye Parsons on the current
6 financial crisis was shared. Additional information on resources that related to the credit
7 crisis was also shared.

8
9 The annual report of the Stated Clerk was received. The number of elders and
10 ministers attending the meetings of the year was reported as was the racial ethnic elder
11 breakdown for 2007. The Clerk recommended that the Presbytery of Florida authorize
12 an additional elder commissioner from Bethel, First Korean, Ft. Walton, Pensacola
13 Korean, Pleasant Grove and Trinity United Presbyterian Church. This was approved.
14 The clerk moved that the Presbytery of Florida encourage Majority Racial Ethnic
15 Congregations/Sessions which have minority racial ethnic congregants who are elders
16 to send them as elder commissioners to Presbytery of Florida meetings. This was
17 approved.

- 42 • The Presbytery of Florida grants the status of Honorably Retired to Harold (Joe)
Vaughn effective January 1, 2009.
 - 43 • The Presbytery of Florida concurs with Parkway Presbyterian Church's request
44 to grant the title of Pastor Emeritus to Reid Cameron.

45 The cost of living increase for ministers and church workers be 4% in light of the fact
46 that the Consumer Price Index increased 5.4% during the first eight months of 2008;
47 and recommends that sessions/congregations consider raising the automobile
48 expenses of ministers in light of the reported increase of 35.6% for fuel costs during the
49 same period.

- 19 • That the New Church Development and Revitalization and Evangelism
20 Committees be combined into one committee with a total of 9 members and be
21 called Church Development and Evangelism Committee.
- 22 • That the Youth Committee approves members for the Youth Council and their
23 representatives to Council meeting of Presbytery.




39 There were several announcements. The next stated meeting of Presbytery will be
