THE SESSION & CONGREGATION COMMIT TO:

1. Participate fully in the redevelopment process with the pastor and the presbytery.
2. Plan and work with the pastor and the Presbytery of Florida Church Development and Evangelism Committee.
3. Begin or continue developing the spiritual energy of the church.
4. Work with the pastor to come to terms with the past, present and future of the church.
5. Re-engage the congregation to assess community needs and ministry opportunities.
6. Build a ministry team that can lead the change in ministry in the church.
7. Develop a stewardship plan to support the redevelopment efforts including a commitment of current church financial resources.
8. Participate fully in the life of the presbytery and financially support its work.
9. Participate in a review process with the session and presbytery to determine the outcome.

THE PASTOR COMMITS TO:

1. Participate fully in the redevelopment process with the church and the Presbytery of Florida.
2. Gain skills for leading a redevelopment effort.
3. Plan and work with the session and the Church Development and Evangelism Committee.
4. Begin or continue developing the spiritual energy of the church.
5. Work with the congregation and session to come to terms with the past, present and future of the church.
6. Help the church to re-engage the congregation to assess community needs and ministry opportunities.
7. Build a ministry team that can lead the change in ministry in the church.
8. Develop with the session and congregation a stewardship plan to support the redevelopment efforts including a commitment of current church financial resources.
9. Participate fully in the life of the presbytery
10. Develop and utilize appropriate skills to effectively manage the dynamics of change and conflict management.
11. Engage in intentional self-care, including physical, emotional and spiritual care.
